Positions of influence









Parents in paid maternity/paternity leave by birthyear of child 2015




Interviewees in news and news related programs by gender 2014–2015






Graduations by diploma 2012/2013



Graduations at tertiary level 2012/2013




Population 25–64 years by education levels 2016
